Mission Statement

The Rainbow Lake Community Advisory Committee provides a forum for regular liaison and discussion between the Community of Rainbow Lake, Town Council and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police concerning policing services, community problems and proactive intervention programming. The Committee provides a forum for residents, taxpayers, business people, concerned citizens or groups to present their complaints, concerns, or requests to both Town Council and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

Goals

The aim of the Rainbow Lake Community Advisory Committee is to:

1. Be accountable to the community.
2. Allow the citizens to have input into the setting of priorities and play an active role in dealing with crime and other community problems through a full partnership between the police, the community and the Town of Rainbow Lake.
3. Work with neighbourhood groups and agencies to deal with factors underlying neighbourhood problems.
4. Adapt to ever-changing environments and confront the emerging issues of the day, whether these are particular forms of crime, legal and political changes, or the concerns of highly vulnerable groups.
