

By-law NO. 48

A By-law of the New Town of Rainbow Lake regarding the  
Discharge of Firearms and the setting off of Firecrackers within the Boundaries of the  
New Town

Under the authority and subject to the provisions of Section 152 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter 68 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1968 and amendments thereto, the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Rainbow Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the discharging of guns or other firearms and the firing and setting off of fire balls, squibs, crackers or fire works shall be prohibited at all times within the boundaries of the New Town of Rainbow Lake.

THAT any person who commits a breach of this by-law shall be liable on summary conviction thereof, before a Magistrate or other officer having jurisdiction, to a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (100.00) and costs, and in default thereof to imprisonment with or without hard labour in the nearest common goal for any period not exceeding sixty days (60) unless such fine and costs, including the costs of committal, are sooner paid.

This by-law shall come into force immediately upon the passing thereof.
